4. **Business arising**
  - Adelaide Hills Road name changes - Dept of Transport Consultation paper will remain out in the community until May. Chelsea to send email with most popular names nominated on the survey GCA put around town.
  - Digital TV update- Received a Press release from Steve Conroy announcing the Federal Govt and Broadcasters will be paying for upgrades to transmitter stations for blackspots around Australia. We will put further details in the next GCA newsletter.
  - Letter of congratulations to Mark Goldsworthy and that we look forward to our continuing relationship. Lee to do.
  - Letter of support for TV Kindergym in seeking a grant- The committee agreed and a letter provided to Chelsea for the Kindergym.
  - Tourism Touch Screens - Gumeracha to be on the list IF enough businesses participate. If we want the Heritage Walk listed on there the minimum cost is \$345 (one off production cost) and then \$210 per quarter. -The committee agreed this was an expense we couldn't afford and would be for a limited market. We anticipate we will gain more from developing our own website.
  - Bushfire Survival Kits, presentation by CFS at future meeting. As Jane was unwell and unable to attend tonight's meeting, this item will go on next months agenda.
  - Website development (Kerrie)- Proposal presented and well received. The costs for setup and ongoing that Kerrie has sourced are extremely reasonable. Sub committee to meet again to set up dummy site. Aim for 1<sup>st</sup> July launch.
  - Bus stops in Albert Street- Chelsea has spoken to Val Hall seeking advice on the next steps to take regarding liasing with AHC. The Bus Company has provided figures for usage of buses for February.
  - ACCU Lottery Tickets (lee)- Still some outstanding books. If we can get them returned by 19<sup>th</sup> April unsold books can be returned and we should get the funds raised within 4 weeks. Please return books to Lee ASAP.
  - Heritage Walk brochures (Financial Support update)- All invoices have been issued to sponsors. Once payment has been received we will order more brochures and a thank you letter sent to all sponsors.
  - Medieval Fair preparation- Daryn has been able to get 20 free loaves of bread, he will try for 50 free as we need 100 loaves all up. Daryn can also purchase sausages for \$2.99/kg, 80kg required.

Don has booked cool room and Joe will collect.
