3. **Minutes of the previous meeting** - Monthly meeting May 10<sup>th</sup> 2010. Moved Brett 2<sup>nd</sup> Rob
4. **Business arising**
  - Discussion regarding Bus stops and shelters, speeding through town and footpath to the Rocking Horse. Val Hall will attend our July meeting to discuss in detail. Lee will draw up a list of points from our discussion to work thru with Val.  
Letter to council to thank them for starting the footpath process.
  - Feedback from Council Budget session. Chelsea brought along a document she was provided with regarding the session and this is available for anyone to read should they wish. One point that came out was we won't be getting green waste this budget, possibly next budget.
  - Invoices for advertising on TIB and Website - Package of advertising costs which can include TIB (limit of 10 advertisers), Newsletter, Webpage, Sponsor ad on the website. Current invoices for TIB and website to be issued with a note saying there will be a limit of 10 TIB advertisers. Invoiced amounts will remain the same as last year at this stage.
  - Youth History Walk- Youth engagement project to establish a walk created by local youth of the town. Photography, graphic design and creating a poster and then a show of their work. Chelsea will write to Anne and say we support the idea, but it will depend on our level of commitment on how we can help.
  - School Business Community Partnership Brokers - Lee and Brett attended a meeting with these people. The discussion revolved around increasing the retention rates of kids staying in school and completing year 12 by way of mentoring kids, and engaging them in activities that can be mutually beneficial to the kids and the mentors. It was agreed we would invite Sasha and Renee from School Business Community Partnership Brokers to our August meeting. Lee to arrange.
  - Advantage SA Regional Awards. We have received an application to enter our Heritage Walk brochure in the Awards. Application to be completed by August 2.
  - Website development - A copy of the Certificate of Incorporation has been ordered from Consumer and Business Affairs which is required for new website application. This has now been received and given to Kerrie with a copy of the Constitution.
  - ACCU Lottery Tickets - Tickets have been returned and we have received a cheque for \$560.
  - Heritage Walk brochures- New stock still to be ordered with changed artwork. Lee to arrange.
